

# Jive Plate

## Ware

Suitable plate with 10" surface. Piece used was Gare 10" Classic Coupe Dinner Plate, Item number 1604.

## Color

Mayco Colors SC-74 Hot Tamale SC-15 Tuxedo FN-001 White FN-9 Black

### **Brushes and Tools**

Sponge

#4 Shader

#1 Liner

Fan Brush

Clay Carbon

Sheet Protector or Tile for Glaze

Red Pencil

Regular Pencil

Ruler

Water Bowl

**Paper Towels** 

#### Instructions

- 1. Wipe dust from properly fired cone 04 bisque.
- 2. With clay carbon, transfer the circle template to the center of the plate. Measure the center of the plate, 5", place the clay carbon, and then the pattern on top. Do your best to align the center of the plate and the center of the pattern to create an even 6" circle in the center.
- 3. Glaze the center of the circle with two coats of FN-001. Let it dry thoroughly.
- 4. With clay carbon, transfer the pattern.
- 5. Glaze "JIVE" with SC-74 doing your best to stay in the lines. For the best look, glaze three coats, allowing them to dry in between.
- 6. Using SC-15 and a liner brush, glaze the musical notes and lines. Take your time and be patient, detail work can be stressful.
- 7. Using SC-15 and a liner brush, outline "JIVE".
- 8. Glaze the outside of your circle, and the back of the plate with three coats of FN-9. Allow to dry between each coat.
- 9. Stilt ware and fire to cone 06.
- 10. Remove stilt marks.
