### **Supplies needed:**

Soft fan brush, Assorted small round brushes, Liner brush, Water bowl, Sponge

### **Glazes:**

SC015 Tuxedo,

SC003 Wine About It,

SC103 Lavendear,

SC027 Sour Apple,

SC045 My Blue Heaven,

SC088 Tu Tu Tango,

SC086 Old Lace,

SC026 Green Thumb,

SC051 Poo Bear,

SC023 Jack O'Lantern,

SC076 Cara-Bein Blue,

SG401 Black,

SC036 Irish Luck,

SC016 Cotton Tail,

Mayco Designer Liner

SC006 Sunkissed,

SC40 Blueberry Hill,

### **Directions:**

Wipe bisque with moist sponge to remove any dust.

Apply 2 -3 coats of all Stroke and Coat (let dry between coats).

With a soft fan brush apply SC015 Tuxedo to inside of top hat.

Base coat outside of top hat with SC027 Sour Apple, hands and face SC086 Old Lace, Beard and eyebrows SC023 Jack O'Lantern, both hat bands SC036 Irish Luck, Leprechaun hat and shoes SC015 Tuxedo, Hat buckle SC006 Sunkissed, Shirt SC003 Wine About It, Pants SC045 My Blue Heaven, Clover SC026 Green Thumb, Eyes use a stylist or back of a brush and dot SC076 Cara-Bein Blue,

-Size flower pattern to your piece and trace what flowers you want to use to tissue paper, then transfer to your top hat by placing tissue paper on the top hat and tracing using a black sharpie.

Use included color map for flower color placement. Outline flowers and large hat band with Designer Liner.

Dilute SC015 Tuxedo into a wash, load your liner brush, and use the tip of brush to allow the wash to flow into the detail of your leprechaun and the clover.
